TO-DO

- Look for legginess, uneven growth, foliage discoloration, dead leaves or branches, and signs of insect infestation or disease.
- If roots grow in a tight circle or emerge from the soil, the plant may need a larger pot.
- Choose a new pot 1-2" larger than the current pot, remove old soil, add fresh organic potting mix, and replant.
- Trim uneven growth and remove dead leaves and discolored foliage periodically.

Potted plants need care at any time of the year, but late summer is the perfect time to repot them and give them a new lease on life.
