TO-DO

- Cut back foliage, stems, leaving a few inches of growth. Decide how many new plants you want to make — each new clump/chunk should have at least three stems.
- Leave enough space for the plants to fill in. Plants that have been divided should be watered until their root systems are established.

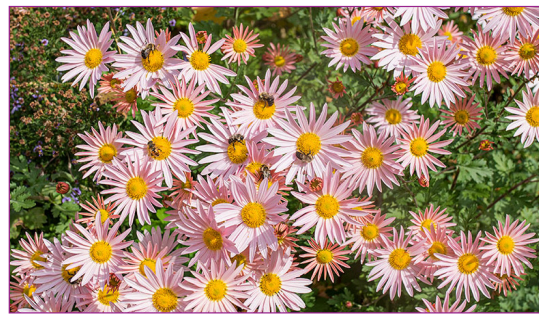
