Apply for the PHS's 2023 preseason Green Industry Bootcamp training

The Pennsylvania Horticultural Society's department of workforce development in partnership with the City of Philadelphia are recruiting for our green industry job training bootcamp happening spring 2023. This paid, six-week training will introduce individuals to the rapidly growing green



industry in and around Philadelphia. Participants will take part in classroom & hands on training in basic ecology, landscape maintenance and tool & equipment operation. Additional workshops in Job readiness will also be included in the training. Upon completion, trainees will graduate and be placed in full time jobs with long term potential within PHS's network of employer partners. The training is broken down into three phases:

- Core Skills Training: 4 weeks of hands-on & classroom-based training in Green Industry Fundamentals
- On the Job Internship: 2 weeks on the job training with an industry employer
- **Graduation & Job Placement:** Full time job placement with employer.

Weekly schedule: Monday - Friday 8am-2:30pm

WHERE: FDR Park in South Philadelphia, Philadelphia Parks & Recreation Community Clubhouse

ADMISSION CRITERIA:

- 1. Must be over 18 years of age and a resident of Philadelphia
- 2. Be legally eligible to work in Pennsylvania
- 3. Be comfortable working outdoors in a variety of weather conditions
- 4. Be physically able to perform all tasks associated with an outdoor, physical labor position
