TO-DO

- Plant at 3x the height of the bulb. Create mixed plantings by layering larger and smaller bulbs, with larger planted deeper. Avoid planting in straight lines — think about how bulbs would grow in nature. Add bulb fertilizer, if you wish.
- Compress soil. If you have squirrels, cover temporarily with netting or chicken wire. Try to plant just before expected rain to deter squirrels from digging up bulbs. If possible, label location.

Sprinkle chili pepper flakes in soil to deter squirrels from digging up newly planted bulbs.
