Overview

PHS Overview

PHS believes in the power of horticulture to make positive social and environmental change. We use horticulture as a tool to advance health and well-being in the Greater Philadelphia region. As a community, we invest our time, passion, money, and gardens in our cause.

Tree Tenders Program Overview

The Greater Philadelphia region needs more trees. While a "good" tree canopy coverage (the area of land shaded by trees) is considered to be 30% of land area, the city of Philadelphia only has 20% coverage and as little as 2.5% in some neighborhoods.

PHS is committed to increasing the tree canopy, especially in neighborhoods with few trees and experiencing high rates of poverty, heat exposure, air quality and health issues, and crime. Throughout the year, PHS works with more than 100 community groups, including your local Tree Tenders group, to plant and care for trees in the Philadelphia region.

PHS's Tree Tenders program works with volunteer-based community groups and municipalities to plant trees throughout the Greater Philadelphia Community. The program provides workshops in tree

planting and care and volunteer group organization. PHS has trained more than 5,200 people who have gone on to lead volunteers in planting over 25,000 trees.

Apply for Trees

By applying for a tree – whether within the Philadelphia city limits or in the surrounding counties – homeowners are supporting PHS Tree Tenders' mission to create a greener and healthier Philadelphia region. PHS assists Philadelphia homeowners in securing the necessary city permits, cutting sidewalks, and providing the tree and planting supplies. With the help of volunteers, the local Tree Tenders group assists new tree owners in planting their tree and provides outreach and support throughout the year so tree parents can continue to grow their knowledge and stewardship of their new tree.

The next tree plantings will take place in April 2022, but the deadline for property owners to apply for a street or front lawn tree is [enter your Tree Tenders group's personal deadline].



Studies have linked increased tree canopy (the area of land shaded by trees) to lower rates of violence and better health outcomes, including reduction in heat-related illness. The <u>US Forest</u> <u>Service</u> researchers estimate that achieving 30% tree canopy would prevent 400 premature deaths per year in Philadelphia. With this statistic in mind, the Greater Philadelphia region still needs more trees. According to a study conducted in 2018 by <u>The City of Philadelphia and</u> <u>University of Vermont Spatial Analysis Lab</u>, the region's tree canopy declined by 6% from 2008-2018, averaging only 20% tree canopy, and with some Philadelphia neighborhoods having as little as 2.5% tree canopy.

PHS Tree Tenders is a core component of PHS's primary areas of impact, including creating healthy living environments and building social connections. The Tree Tenders semi-annual training program offers low-cost education in tree planting/care to individuals and volunteer community groups, primarily in the Philadelphia region as well as worldwide via online training sessions. PHS has trained more than 5,000 volunteers who have gone on to form community groups that rally neighbors to come together to plant and care for trees. During PHS's November 2020 and April 2021 tree planting events, volunteers planted more than 2,000 trees. Since its inception, PHS Tree Tenders groups have planted over 25,000 trees in neighborhoods across the Greater Philadelphia region. Throughout the year, PHS plants and cares for trees and works towards the goal of a healthier urban forest, especially for neighborhoods with low canopy coverage and high average temperatures.

Get Involved with PHS Tree Tenders

Property owners in [neighborhood name] are encouraged to apply for street trees for the next round of plantings in [April OR November] [year]. Free trees and sidewalk removal will be

limited to up to 3 trees per property owner, and the ability to secure trees is based on available funding.
