- · No swimming or entering water features.
- Smoking, vaping, illegal substances, alcohol, and weapons are prohibited on the property.
- Pets (aside from service animals) are not permitted.
- Picnic at designated picnic tables only. Carry out what you bring in and do not leave belongings unattended.
- Please note that many areas of the garden are not accessible to strollers or wheelchairs.
- The taking of cuttings, seeds, or flowers. is prohibited.
