The program is managed by PHS in collaboration with the Philadelphia Prison System, Department of Housing and Community Development, Defender Association of Philadelphia, Office of the District Attorney, the Mayor's Office of Reintegration Services (RISE), and CareerLink.

The PHS Philadelphia LandCare program is a nationally recognized model of landscape treatment and urban revitalization. As part of a strategic approach to neighborhood redevelopment, LandCare works with community-based organizations and city agencies to transform Philadelphia's vacant land into neighborhood assets.
